THE NOIRE PAGEANT (2021-2022)

An ongoing mentorship program offering 1:1 and group courses focusing on the elevation of BIPOC, women, and queer performing artists. Founded and personally run by the black queen of burlesque: Perle Noire.

THE AUDACITY PROJECT (2020-2021)

An 8-week Business mentorship course for performing arts professionals. Created by internationally acclaimed Aerialist, Speaker, and Coach: Rachel Strickland.

FIRE UNIVERSITY (2016-2020)

A private club for fire spinning enthusiasts, produced and managed by a small crew of Burning Man enthusiasts and certified Fire Safety specialists in Davis, CA. Participating artists learn about fire props, fire safety practices, and regularly attend festivals together to practice their art in the field. Affiliated events include Firedrums, Stilldream, and more.

Education focused on Technical Theatre, Classical Acting (specifically drawing on The Stanislavsky Method, designed to effectively manipulate an audience into a state of authentic full-immersion). Students were encouraged to widen their horizons within the curriculum, exploring a wide variety of dance styles and psychological approaches within varying sociological environments.

STUDIO 24: "ACTING ON FILM" PROGRAM (2015)

A 6-week intensive focusing on the difference between acting on film vs. theatre. Actors explore a small collection of scenes, ranging from dramatic to comedic, and must adapt to the high-pressure environment of working on a film set. Produced and personally taught by working actor and studio founder, Cody Dorkin.

Specializing Taekwondo (Robinson's), Taekuk Musul (GM Suk Ku Kim), and 5 Animal Style Combat (as taught by an active CHP officer and Wushu enthusiast). 1st black belt acquired in 1998. Teaching classes and 1:1s since 2000. Competed in dozens of martial arts tournaments every year, often bringing home the Gold in national championships sponsored by Disney and Tiger Claw.
